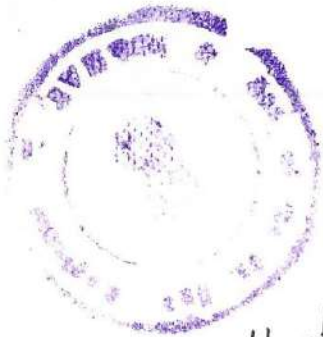

1,25,000 (one lac and twenty five thousand) with intent and purpose of founding a school to be named 'Hemalata-Hameliqui Memorial Institute (English Medium) (P.T.O. Cankel 2-2) at gorhat for the education and training of young boys and girls as well as admit in education and vocational pursuits and for the development of character so as to produce law-abiding, beardless and healthy citizens and whereas the trustees above named are willing to be invested with the amount stated above for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the donor. Under the directions set for the here in. Now is hereby directed by the donor as follows (1) That the donor conveys transfers and grants unto the trustees the above mentioned sum of Rs 1,25,000/- (one lac and twenty five thousand) to have and to hold the same in trust for the objects of the trust as described below to be used and appropriated by the trustees in order to carry out and fulfil the said objects in accordance with the directions of the donor and the donor hereby relinquishes for all time any claim to an interest in the above

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mentioned amount (Here in after called the Subject matter of the Trust) (a) The objects of the Trust are (i) To open and continue an educational and vocational Higher Secondary School or Institution with Kindergarten classes in healthy and ~~real~~ healthy and salubrious surroundings and to add one class every year till the institution is complete with the eleventh class or the highest class prescribed by the educational authorities. In the primary Secondary and Higher Secondary stages, the number of pupils in each class shall not exceed forty and each class shall be divided into two sections, each section consisting of not more than twenty pupils (P.T.O. contd.)

3) (ii) To engage teachers of good moral character and Conduct able to impart efficiently up-to-date instruction to pupils in intellectual, industrial and other useful pursuits so as to make them good Citizens (iii) To construct school buildings and to establish, maintain and run boarding houses and

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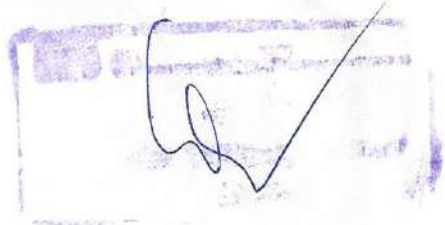

Residential institution for the students and those connected with the institution (iv) To invest, dispose of and otherwise deal with the subject matter of the trust in such a manner as the trustees should deem fit to carry on the objects of the trust effectively by further extension, if necessary for furthering the cause of education (v) To accept donations, grants, loans, presents and other offerings and to deal with the same for the purpose of the trust. (3) The trustees shall manage the subject matter of the Trust as economically and with circumspection as they may jointly at a meeting or by circulation resolve upon Sri P. K. Benooah, referred to above, will be the chairman for life and Mr. D. N. Benooah, Sri V. Nachanar Benooah, Sri B. L. Hendrickson M.A. and Sri Muralidhar Benooah B.A. mentioned above will be life members of the Board of trustees and the Inspector of Schools, Upper Anam Circle will be the ex-officio member thereof.

Among circle shall be deemed to include the officer who is for the time being the chief officer of the government in the education department of the district in which the town or village is situated whether permanent or temporary. A member from the family of the donor will always be a member of the Board of Trustees. If any vacancy arises in the Board on account of death, incapacity or persistent neglect on the part of any trustee, the remaining trustees unanimously or by majority (P.T.O. could 4) may co-opt any person deemed suitable. After Sec B.L. Banooah, a new Chairman will be elected by the Board of Trustees (4) The Trust Board will also act as a managing Committee with powers to co-opt members only for the management of the school. (5) Sec B.L. Handique MA mentioned above will be the Secy of the trust Board and of the Managing Committee during his life time (6) The donor has invested the trustees with the ownership of the subject matter of the trust who have agreed to accept the trust
